



Helios & Matheson posts 58% rise in FY07 net

■ **CHENNAI:** Helios & Matheson Information Technology, the 16-year-old Chennai-based IT services firm, has posted a net profit of Rs 59.91 crore in the year ended March 31, 2007, up by 58% over Rs 38.02 crore in the previous year. Income rose by 78.7% to Rs 395.58 crore. The board has approved a 20% interim dividend as a special dividend to celebrate the company's 15th anniversary. Last year, operating profit stood at Rs 85.13 crore, up by 50% over Rs 56.94 crore in the previous year. Cash equivalents as on March 31, 2007 stood at Rs 109.06 crore. EPS increased to Rs 29.94. "Our efforts in developing the client base and expanding strategic accounts have fuelled our robust organic model." MD G K Muralikrishna said.
